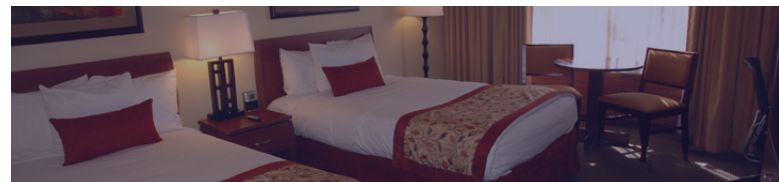
## PROGRAM INFORMATION
