



People with mental illness are 9 times more likely to be incarcerated than hospitalized.

In 44 states, a jail or prison holds more mentally ill individuals than the largest remaining state psychiatric hospital.

Nearly half (49%) of State prisoners who had a mental health problem had a violent offense as their most serious offense, followed by property (20%) and drug offenses (19%).
